Investment Objective

The Washington State Bond Fund seeks to provide returns while controlling risk by investing in high-quality corporate bonds. The fund's performance objective is to match or exceed the return of the Bloomberg Intermediate Credit Index.

Investment strategy

The Washington State Bond Fund employs an active strategy that seeks to add incremental value over the index. The fund normally invests in a diversified portfolio of investment-grade corporate securities. The portfolio intends to earn additional returns through security selection, but will be allowed to deviate from the index's duration by plus or minus 25 percent.

Investment risk

The Washington State Bond Fund is intended for participants who want an investment designed to match or modestly exceed the returns of the Bloomberg Intermediate Credit Index. It is intended as an intermediate-term investment vehicle due to the moderate level of returns on fixed income instruments over short time periods.




